OFFICE ORDER

A committee was constituted by Director, ICAR-IIMR vide email dated 4th May, 2021 under the Chairmanship of Chairman, Farm Management Committee, IIMR HQ, Ludhiana to come out for faster procedure for sale/auction of farm produce. Accepting the recommendations of the Committee dated 1/6/2021, following are hereby approved by Director, ICAR-IIMR, Ludhiana regarding the sale of farm produce for IIMR HQ and its regional stations:-

1. All farm produces will be sold under the supervision of Farm Management Committees of all IIMR HQ and its regional stations through a suitable mechanism viz. Sale Counter etc. at minimum support price (MSP) declared by the Government.
2. Sale in the first instances will be made to the Skilled Supporting Staff, Class-IV Staff, Daily Paid Laborers and contractual labourers/staff (Highly Skilled, Skilled, Semi-Skilled and Un-skilled Staff) of ICAR-IIMR and other locally situated ICAR Institutes, Central / State Agricultural Universities.
3. Any unsold farm produce after mentioned in the point no. 2 above, farm produces will be sold to the general public at MSP.
4. After making efforts as mentioned in the point no. 2 & 3, if any quantity of produce still remains unsold, the same will be disposed off through Public Auction by Farm Management Committee after deciding the Base Price with the approval of Director, IIMR. The base price of for the commodities will be assessed only once in a year and the auction may be conducted at multiple times in a year based on that base price.
5. Minimum and maximum permissible quantity of the farm produce to a single buyer shall be as under:-

S.No.	Farm Produce	Minimum Qty (Kg)	Maximum Qty (Kg)
1.	Wheat	25	100
2.	Maize	25	200
3.	Urad	5	25
4.	Moong	5	25
5.	Paddy	10	25
6	Soya Bean	5	20
7	Arhar	5	20

In case of there is drastic variation in crop production in any season/year, the quantity may be changed by Farm Management Committee with the approval of Director, ICAR-IIMR keeping in view the quantity of Farm Produces. No bulk buying by a single or few person should be allowed under any circumstances.

Proper record of the sale shall be maintained by the respective Farm Management Committee under the supervision of R.S. Incharge/Chairperson and the revenue generated may be deposited to the IIMR account immediately. It may be ensure that before starting the sale wide publicity of the sale, crops, venue, dates and timings etc. is made well in advance. Farm produce will be kept in safe custody using appropriate measures by the respective In-charges/Chairman Farm Committee till it is sold or auctioned.

This provision will be reviewed after one year.

This issues with the approval of Director, ICAR-IIMR, Ludhiana.
